The Company has head office in Kolkata and Branch Office in Ahemdabad, Pune and Coimbatore.

Lalwani Ferro Alloys Limited is an unlisted public company, incorporated on 27th November, 1986. It has a paid-up capital of Rs. 6.07 Crore. Mr. Kamal Kishore Lalwani, Mrs. Snehlata Lalwani, Mr. Sandeep Lalwani and Mrs. Ruchi Lalwani are the directors of the company.

Introduction to Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR):

In today's fast speed world each business whether big or small needs to have CSR programme in place.

As per Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 which pertains to the CSR law for the companies, we have constituted a Corporate Social Responsibility Committee with Independent Directors. Ms. Venus Kedia and Ms. Priya Gupta are the Independent Directors of the Company and the members of the CSR Committee along with Mr. Sandeep Lalwani as the Chairman of the Committee.

CSR Policy:

The Company has formulated a CSR Policy which clearly mentions the CSR activities carried out as per Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013. The Company is a manufacturing concern and has its unit located at Barjora. Since years, we have been providing employment to the people living in this area with limited means. We are trying our best to raise the standard of living of the people there by setting up, in association with local hospitals at Barjora, Blood Donation Camp and free Dental and Eye Check up Camps every year. We supply water and distribute blankets to the villagers of Barjora during summers and winters respectively.

FOCUSED GEOGRAPHIC SPREAD

The Company's focus areas for developmental activities will be in urban as well as rural areas in the state in which it is located.

The Company may also support initiatives in other geographies, as approved by the board from time to time.

We will ensure that all communities benefit from our CSR activities, we would focus on those groups that are socially and economically marginalized. These would include women, girl children, etc.

THRUST AREAS

Education

- Promoting education including special education and employment enhancing vocation skills especially among children, women, and elderly.
- Educate the people on sanitation, cleanliness, and good habits through counselors appointed by company.
- Education - Adult education programme, Vocational Training programmes for the unemployed youths, , Consumer awareness programme, awareness on farming, poultry farming, modern techniques for optimum utilization of the land resource, water-harvesting techniques and its benefits, etc., Scholarships to the economically backward village school children, organising drawing competitions, providing computers for the school and any material that help the children etc.

CSR Expenses:

As per Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 every company, on which CSR is applicable, shall spend, in every financial year, at least 2% of the average net profits of the company made during the three immediately preceding financial years towards the CSR.

As per the provision during the financial year 2022-23 the company was liable to spend an amount of Rs. 1.67 Crores toward the CSR. In the financial year 2021-22 the company had spent an excess of Rs. 33.13 Lacs. Hence, in the financial year 2022-23 the company was liable to spend an amount of Rs. 1.34 Crores.

During the financial year 2022-23 the company has spent an amount of Rs. 1.46 Crores among the ten different projects. These projects were recommended by the CSR Committee and Company had given the preferences to the Promotion of Education, Development of Rural Areas and Eradication the Hunger.

2. Project Overview:

a. Description of the project:

- Acharya Mahapragya Medical College and Hospital is a constituent college of the Jain Vishva Bharati Institute (Deemed University); i.e. the same is being fully managed and maintained by the Institute.
- Since HH Acharyashree Mahaprajna had an ideology focused on naturally occurring and minimally-invasive methods and had a trust on the healing power of the nature, the JVBI, on the eve of his birth centenary had decided to establish a Medical College and hospital of naturopathy & Yoga. The said Medical College shall have a dedicated Hospital, which has already been constructed and the same has been housed in an imposing building

located in a lush green, eco-friendly, calm and serene atmosphere with salubrious climate.

- The University has created a state-of-the-art infrastructure for the Hospital of Naturopathy and yoga, which shall be functioning in its dedicated building, where provisions have been made for the out-patient department facilities like Consultation room, Separate treatment section for male and female, Yoga hall, Magneto therapy, Massage room, Steam bath room etc. Separate facilities for males and females have been developed for admitted patients. It shall have a rich Library and other facilities for the patients.
- The Hospital and Medical College has been developed on a piece of land measuring 7.6 acres of land, with a provision of 39,440 sq. feet constructed area. The said Medical College Building has a state-of-the-art infrastructure for ensuring a cost-effective and efficient non-invasive therapy to be made available to the people mostly belonging to disadvantaged sections.
- The Institute has completed the construction of the building for the said College and also for the Hospital.
- The Institute has put in place furniture and fixtures.
- Facilities for housing the patients have been completed.
- Recruitment of the Doctors and support staff is in process and expectedly shall be completed by the end of this month.

- An Assistant Director, who is former personnel of the Jindal Nature Institute, Bengaluru has already been appointed and is supervising the affairs. v. The University has submitted its application in the prescribed format on 7th October 2020 to the Dept. of Health, Govt. of Rajasthan for issuance of the NOC as per rules along with prescribed fee of Rs. One Lakh. It is in process.
